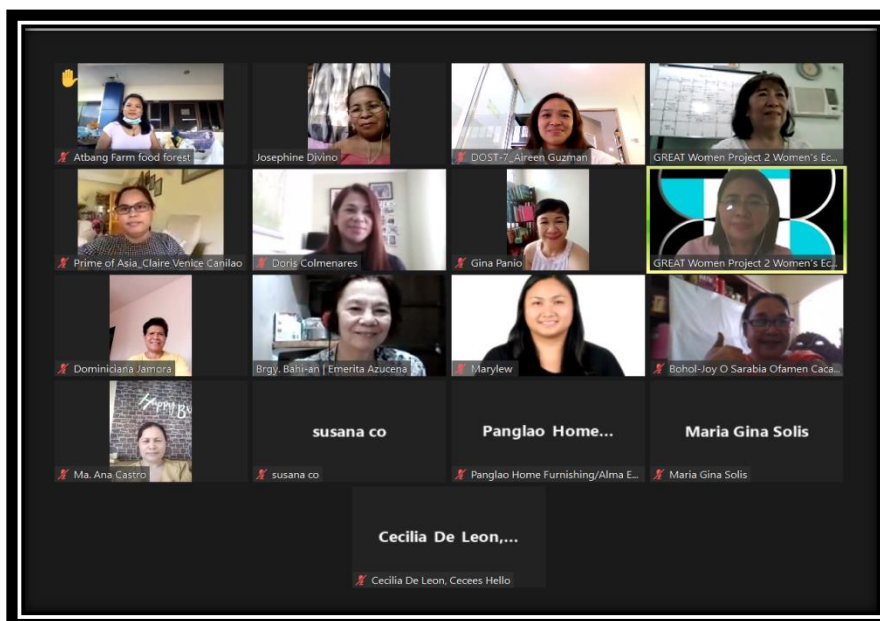


WMEs heightens knowledge on Food Processing Training
